

Assessment: Making my own parable - Year 7 Religious Education

Task: To produce a parable (story with a moral message) in the form of a booklet, role-play (with script) or storyboard suitable for a primary school pupil who is in Year 4.

What you should include:

- a) The main text (book/role-play script/ storyboard)
- b) Pictures (ICT or your own drawings)
- c) A presentation to the class
- d) A moral message within your story

Assessment guidelines

Level 3: For this level you will have written a short story and will have included a picture.

Level 4: In addition to level 3 you will have explained the message behind your story. You will have used a good range of vocabulary so that your story flows clearly and is easy to read.

Level 5: In addition to levels 3 and 4 you will have included and carefully presented set of pictures to go with your story (either through ICT or your own pictures). Your grammar will be good and spelling will be accurate. The moral message will be clearly evident to the reader.

Level 6: In addition to the earlier levels you will have excellent command of vocabulary and your presentation will be exceptional. Your work would have been written in a style, which really captures the reader, and your pictures will be appropriate.
